Respectful Yarns Workshop

Respectful Yarns, a 3 hour workshop, takes a deeper look at the Cultural Competency Continuum as a tool to support and improve cross cultural communication between Indigenous and non-Indigenous Australians. It uses the Aboriginal 8 Ways of Learning to develop strategies to improve cultural competency and cross cultural communication skills. Attendees leave the workshop with a coolamon (traditional wooden container) of cross-cultural communication skills they can apply in their workplace and communities.
