Hard This 3 hour facilitated small group yarn has been developed to create a safe professional space to generate discussion and questions regarding cultural safety and competency and how this relates to policies and procedures in the workplace.

An Indigenous facilitator supports the discussion with attendees to consider ways to develop policies which are meaningful to and created with Indigenous staff, clients, and communities. This workshop would suit Management, Leadership and Executive staff.
